## ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO COLLECT

*We are not accepting clothing or shoes. Donated items must be unused and not expired. All goods must have an expiration date of February 2022 or later.*

### Most critically needed items:

- Canned and dried beans
- Baby diapers and wipes
- Baby food and cereal
- Premixed baby formula
- Feminine hygiene pads
- Adult diapers
- 4-to-6-person tents
- Tarps

### Other needed items include:

- Shelf-stable milk
- Hygiene items: soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, washcloths
- Personal cleansing cloths
- Paper towels and toilet paper
- Canned foods and nonperishable items
- School supplies
- Cleaning supplies and products
- Rain boots
- Flashlights
