### Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18

"Be careful not to practice your righteousness in front of others to be seen by them." (Matthew 6:1)

### My Offering to God:

I will honor Christ by doing a kind deed for a stranger without telling anyone.



### Thursday, February 23, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 9:22-25

"Then He said to them all: Whoever wants to be My disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me." (Luke 9:23)

### My Offering to God:

I will follow Jesus by turning my life over to Him.

### Friday, February 24, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 9:14-15

"The time will come when the bridegroom will be taken from them; then they will fast." (Matthew 9:15)

### My Offering to God:

I will fast today to understand Christ's sacrifice.



### Saturday, February 25, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 5:27-32

"Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?' Jesus answered them, 'It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick." (Luke 5:30-31)

### My Offering to God:

I will share Christ's love with someone in need.

Grow closer to the Lord by giving to others and sharing yourself with those who need you.



### DAY 5

### First Sunday of Lent, February 26, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 4:1-11

"Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." (Matthew 4:4)

### My Offering to God:

Today, I will read my Bible and reflect on God's word.

### Monday, February 27, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 25:31-46

"For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited Me in." (Matthew 25:35)

### My Offering to God:

I will let my love overflow in generosity toward my neighbor.



### Tuesday, February 28, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 6:7-15

"For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you." (Matthew 6:14)

### My Offering to God:

As God our Father forgives me when I sin, I will forgive others who wrong me.

### Wednesday, March 1, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 11:29-32

"For they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and now something greater than Jonah is here." (Luke 11:32)

### My Offering to God:

I will pray today and thank God for the strength He gives me.



### Thursday, March 2, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 7:7-12

"So, in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you."

(Matthew 7:12)

### My Offering to God:

I will put aside my own wants and tend to the needs of others.



### Friday, March 3, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 5:20-26

"First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift." (Matthew 5:24)

### My Offering to God:

I will forgive someone who wronged me.



### Saturday, March 4, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 5:43-48

"But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." (Matthew 5:44)

### My Offering to God:

I will pray for those whom I do not get along with, that I may share Christ's love and forgiveness.

Rely more on God through your prayer, fasting and generosity toward those in need.





### Second Sunday of Lent, March 5, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 17:1-9

"For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."

(Matthew 23:12)

### My Offering to God:

I will be humble in sharing the love of Christ with others, putting Him first.

### Monday, March 6, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 6:36-38

"Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." (Luke 6:36)

### My Offering to God:

I will be merciful and not judge others to reflect God's love.

# DAY 14

### Tuesday, March 7, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 23:1-12

"The greatest among you will be your servant." (Matthew 23:11)

### My Offering to God:

I will show others my love for Christ through my actions instead of mere words.

### Wednesday, March 8, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 20:17-28

"Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many." (Matthew 20:28)

### My Offering to God:

I will thank God for the ultimate sacrifice Jesus gave when He died for our sins.



### Thursday, March 9, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 16:19-31

"At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table." (Luke 16:20-21)

### My Offering to God:

I will share my blessings with the hungry.

### Friday, March 10, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 21:33-43, 45-46

"The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes." (Matthew 21:42)

### My Offering to God:

I will contemplate God's plan for my life and accept His divine will.



### Saturday, March 11, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 15:1-3, 11-32

"But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found." (Luke 15:32)

### My Offering to God:

I will embrace those who lost the Lord and need to find Him again.

Pause for a moment to recognize the solemn beauty of the Lenten season.





### Third Sunday of Lent, March 12, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 4:5-42

"Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life." (John 4:14)

### My Offering to God:

Today, I thank Jesus for His gift of eternal life.

#### Monday, March 13, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 4:24-30

"Truly I tell you,' He continued, 'no prophet is accepted in his hometown."

(Luke 4:24)

### My Offering to God:

If I feel anger, I will pray for calmness in my heart and the grace to speak God's truth.



### Tuesday, March 14, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 18:21-35

"Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times?" Jesus answered, 'I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times."" (Matthew 18:21-22)

### My Offering to God:

I will not bear grudges against those who wronged me and instead I will bear witness to Jesus.

### Wednesday, March 15, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 5:17-19

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them." (Matthew 5:17)

### My Offering to God:

I will love my neighbor as Jesus wants me to and carry His love in my heart.



### Thursday, March 16, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 11:14-23

"Whoever is not with Me is against Me, and whoever does not gather with Me scatters." (Luke 11:23)

### My Offering to God:

I will stand with Jesus and be strong in my faith in Him.

### Friday, March 17, 2023

Gospel reading: Mark 12:28-34

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." (Mark 12:30)

### My Offering to God:

I will share God's love with others through my actions.



### Saturday, March 18, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 18:9-14

"For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."

(Luke 18:14)

### My Offering to God:

I will perform an act of service today.

This week, I will refresh someone who may feel less than worthy in God's eyes





### Fourth Sunday of Lent, March 19, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 9:1-41

"One thing I do know.
I was blind but now I see!"
(John 9:25)

### My Offering to God:

I will spend time alone with God in prayer today.

### Monday, March 20, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 1:16, 18-21, 24

"Why were you searching for me?' He asked. 'Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?""

(Luke 2:49)

### My Offering to God:

I will listen when Jesus calls me to find Him in faith, trust and eternal life.

## DAY 28

### Tuesday, March 21, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 5:1-16

"Then Jesus said to him, 'Get up! Pick up your mat and walk.' At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked." (John 5:8-9)

### My Offering to God:

I will remember that Jesus is compassionate to us in our misery.

### Wednesday, March 22, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 5:17-30

"By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and My judgment is just, for I seek not to please Myself but Him who sent Me." (John 5:30)

### My Offering to God:

I bring glory to God by walking in faith with Jesus.



### Thursday, March 23, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 5:31-47

"For the works that the Father has given Me to finish—the very works that I am doing testify that the Father has sent Me." (John 5:36)

### My Offering to God:

I will strengthen my faith and commitment by studying the words and deeds of Jesus.

### Friday, March 24, 2023

Gospel reading: John 7:1-2, 10, 25-30

"At this they tried to seize Him, but no one laid a hand on Him, because His hour had not yet come."

(John 7:30)

### My Offering to God:

I will allow God to give me a fresh perspective and new life through Jesus Christ.



### Saturday, March 25, 2023

Gospel Reading: Luke 1:26-38

"For no word from God will ever fail." (Luke 1:37)

### My Offering to God:

Today, no matter what situation I find myself in, I will trust that God will work things out for the best.

I will respond to challenging situations I find myself in by having faith in God.





### Fifth Sunday of Lent, March 26, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 11:1-45

"When He had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, 'Lazarus, come out!' The dead man came out ..." (John 11:43-44)

### My Offering to God:

I will reflect on the authority of God's words.

#### Monday, March 27, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 8:1-11

"Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." (John 8:7)

### My Offering to God:

I will put down my stone and embrace people who need Christ's love just as I do.



### Tuesday, March 28, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 8:21-30

"... I do nothing on My own, but I say only what the Father taught Me." (John 8:28)

### My Offering to God:

Today, I will praise our Lord Jesus for His obedience and love.

### Wednesday, March 29, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 8:31-42

"If you hold to My teaching, you are really My disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31-32)

### My Offering to God:

I will continue in God's Word and experience the freedom He promises.



### Thursday, March 30, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 8:51-59

"... I do know Him and obey His word."

(John 8:55)

### My Offering to God:

I will allow Jesus to use me to bring more people to Him.

### Friday, March 31, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 10:31-42

"And in that place many believed in Jesus." (John 10:42)

### My Offering to God:

I will make a difference in the lives of those around me.



### Saturday, April 1, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 11:45-56

"... he prophesied that Jesus would die for the Jewish nation, and not only for that nation but also for the scattered children of God, to bring them together and make them one." (John 11:51-52)

### My Offering to God:

Jesus came to die for us all and I will share His good news with those who feel forgotten.

Remember that God's mercy is open wide. Live joyfully in His presence.





Palm Sunday, April 2, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 26:14-27:66

"... My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from Me. Yet not as I will, but as You will." (Matthew 26:39)

### My Offering to God:

I believe that God has a plan for me, and I will pray for His will in my life.

### Monday, April 3, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 12:1-11

"Then Mary took about a pint of pure nard, an expensive perfume; she poured it on Jesus' feet and wiped His feet with her hair ..." (John 12:3)

### My Offering to God:

I will show my thankfulness to the Lord by offering Him my devotion.

## **DAY 42**

### Tuesday, April 4, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 13:21-33, 36-38

"Very truly I tell you, before the rooster crows, you will disown Me three times!" (John 13:38)

### My Offering to God:

I will face the challenges of life and faith by remaining in your presence, Lord.

### Wednesday, April 5, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 26:14-25

"Truly I tell you, one of you will betray Me."
(Matthew 26:21)

### My Offering to God:

This Easter, I will choose Jesus just as He has chosen me.



### Thursday, April 6, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 13:1-15

"You call Me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet." (John 13:13-14)

Today, I will examine my heart and actions to be sure they are in line with Christ's teachings.

### Friday, April 7, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 18:1-19:42

I will honor Christ's sacrifice by living a life of purpose, focus and obedience.



### Saturday, April 8, 2023

Gospel Reading: Matthew 28:1-10

"... Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; He has risen, just as He said." (Matthew 28:5-6)

### My Offering to God:

Today, I will not be afraid because victory is ours in Jesus Christ.

We do not need to be afraid because Jesus Christ is Lord.





### Easter Sunday, April 9, 2023

Gospel Reading: John 20:1-9

"They still did not understand from Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead." (John 20:9)

### My Offering to God:

I will praise God because Jesus is alive!
